The Pollution Prevention Operations Center utilizes P.O.L. Sorb in all of our spill kits intended for petroleum based spills such as oil and JP – 8. We assemble and issue these kits to the US Army in support of the 101st Airborne Division, Air Assault, 5th Special Forces Group and 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (SOAR).

These kits are used in support of over 450 aircraft and many units include our “kit Bag” kit, which utilizes the 8lb bag of P.O.L. Sorb as a base component, as their on board aircraft kit to insure compliance with environmental regulations at many of the installations and airfields that they fly into.

We have used the P.O.L. Sorb loose particulate as well as pillows and booms as our primary sorbent for more than 5 years and have always been pleased with its performance in the field. It’s lightweight, low cost, high absorbency and hydrophobic properties make it our first choice for dealing with petroleum type spills.
